Federal campaign finance laws strictly prohibit contributions by corporations and/or foreign nationals; hence **no portion** of your contribution may be attributed to either a corporate partner or a partner who is not a U.S. citizen/permanent legal resident of the U.S. PHA PAC appreciates that many organizations consider their partnership lists to be proprietary data. **Specific information relating to the percentage of ownership is not reported; hence the proprietary nature of this information is respected.**

Contributions to PHA PAC are used for political purposes. Contributions to PHA PAC are not tax deductible for federal income tax purposes. All contributions to PHA PAC are voluntary and must be made with personal funds. You may refuse to contribute without reprisal. Any proposed contribution amounts are merely suggestions; you may choose to contribute more or less or not at all. PHA PAC will not favor or disadvantage anyone by reason of the amount contributed or the decision not to contribute. Federal law requires political committees to report the name, address, occupation, and name of employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year. Federal law prohibits corporate contributions. PHA PAC participants must be US citizens or permanent resident aliens.
