

Advanced Metal Detecting for the Archaeologist (AMDA)

The AMDA presents an RPA-certified class offering, which is geared towards providing professional archaeologists with an understanding of current best practices.

The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation will be our local partner for this class. AMDA is certified under the Register of Professional Archaeologists' continuing professional education program. The goal of the class is to provide professional archaeologists with an understanding of current best practices in metal detecting, and to provide the opportunity to gain hands-on experience with a variety of devices from a variety of manufacturers.

The course is offered with 16-credit and 24-credit options. Under the former, there are 8 hours of classroom work and 8 hours of field instruction/experience. Under the latter, the field portion is expanded to 16 hours and the classroom remains 8 hours. Fees will be \$275 for 16 credits and \$350 for 24 credits.
