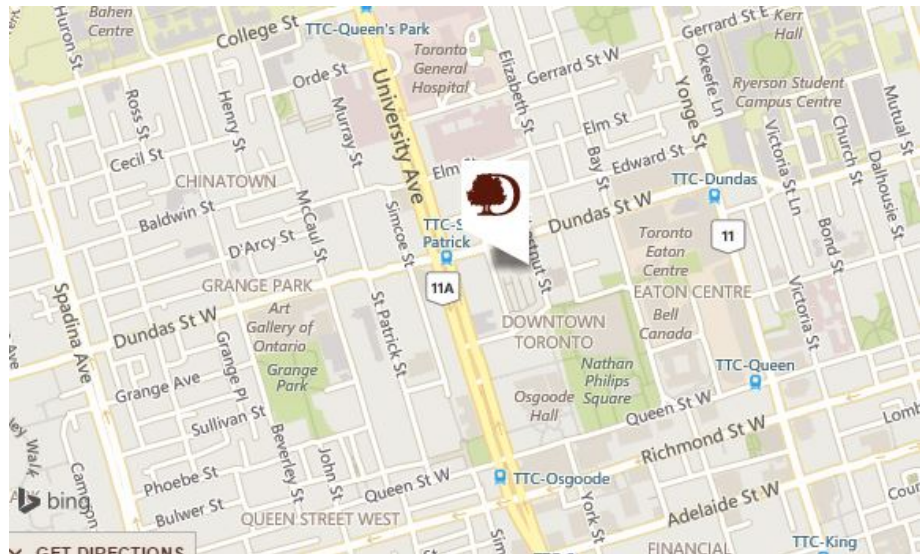

Directions

By car, from the West: Take the 401 Eastbound to the 427 South. Take the 427 South to the QEW Toronto; the QEW changes names to the Gardiner Expressway, remain on this highway until the York/Yonge/Bay Street exit. Take York St. Exit North, follow to University Avenue. Go north to Armoury Street, turn right at stop sign, turn left. Hotel is on the left.

By car, from the East: Take the 401 Westbound to the Don Valley Parkway exit. Take the Don Valley South to the Richmond Street exit. Stay on Richmond Street until you reach University Avenue; at University, turn right and go 2 sets of lights to Armoury Street. Turn right at Armoury and at the stop sign turn left. Hotel is on the left hand side.



Please note the hotel does not provide shuttle service to/from airports.

Closest Rail Station: Union Station (Hotel is an approx. 20-minute walk north of Union Station.)

Closest Subway Station: St. Patrick Station (Line 1 – Yonge/University/Spadina Line). Exit East side of University Avenue on the south side of Dundas Street W., walk east along Dundas for 2 blocks and turn right onto Chestnut Street.
