Function:

Upward Bound instructors have the responsibility to develop curriculum in their area of expertise that will provide instruction as well as enrichment experiences for participants. Instructors are expected to provide a positive learning environment, serve as positive role models, and be supportive of the Upward Bound objectives. The instructors report to the Assistant Director/Academic Coordinator.

Essential Responsibilities:

- 1) Develop course syllabus
- 2) Develop course curriculum
- 3) Provide instruction as assigned
- 4) Evaluate each participant's performance
- 5) Attend Upward Bound staff meetings and Upward Bound in service training
- 6) Maintain accurate records on each participant
- 7) Participate in Awards Night and other activities
- 8) Perform other duties assigned

Requirements:

- 1) Bachelor's degree in appropriate field of study: Algebra, Geometry, Calculus & Trigonometry
- 2) Two years experience teaching

Desired Qualifications:

- 1) Certification in teaching field; preferred but not required
- 2) Must have demonstrated sensitivity to the academic and personal needs of economically and academically disadvantaged youth
- 3) Prefer person with background similar to target population
