


Facilitation: *Developing a Statewide Network of Alumni Chapters*

This **colorful facilitation** will bring out the **creative energy** of AmeriCorps alumni, second-year members, and community partners to develop a **practical action plan**.

Workshop participants will experience:

- **Problem-solving games** to encourage creativity;
- An **interactive mapping activity** to prioritize future chapter locations;
- A fun **goal-setting discussion** for state-wide and local events;
- The motivating process of breaking alumni projects into **manageable tasks**;
- An opportunity to become part of an **alumni chapter leadership team**; and
- Creating a **color-coded, user-friendly action plan** to engage alumni in their community.



Format: Workshop with Facilitated Discussion

Audience: AmeriCorps Alumni, InterCorps Council Members, and Community Partners

Time Requirement: 4 to 6 hours

Room Set-up: 10' to 15' blank wall space, flipcharts, and round tables for small-group discussions

Venues: state service conferences, pre- or post-conference workshops, leadership retreats
