Recognizing outstanding service and leadership through full and partial tuition fellowships

Clark University's International Development, Community, and Environment (IDCE) department offers full and several partial merit-based tuition fellowships to AmeriCorps Alumni. IDCE AmeriCorps Fellowship recipients have demonstrated leadership in their work experience and have been outstanding in their search for thoughtful, realistic, and innovative approaches to international development, advancing social change, building community, and promoting environmental sustainability.

IDCE Offers Master's Degrees in:

- International Development and Social Change
- Community Development and Planning
- Environmental Science and Policy
- Geographic Information Science for Development and Environment

AmeriCorps Alumni Fellowships:

IDCE provides partial tuition fellowships worth at least 40 percent tuition remission (more than \$20,000 at current tuition rates) to all AmeriCorps alumni admitted to one of IDCE's graduate programs. *This fellowship includes and often exceeds the match provided by the AmeriCorps education award.*

Additionally, each year, IDCE awards at least one full tuition-free competitive fellowship for an AmeriCorps alum of extraordinary merit.

Applying for an AmeriCorps Alumni Fellowship:

Candidates must submit:

- Completed Clark/IDCE application for admission (see website for details). Please check the appropriate box on the application to be considered for these fellowships; a separate application is not required.
- Applicants must provide verification of service at the time of the application in order to waive the \$50 application fee.

Deadlines and Notification:

- The application deadline is January 15 for entrance the following fall semester.
- Decision letters will be mailed the third week in March to admitted students.
- All AmeriCorps alumni admitted to one of IDCE's graduate programs will receive partial tuition fellowships worth at least 40 percent tuition remission.
