

30 cal semi-auto only Infantry Trophy Match
Cost to shoot \$10.00

Equipment Required:

- Any Center Fire 30 cal semi-auto Rifle
- Eye Protection
- Ear Protection
- Spotting Scope (optional)
- 64 pounds per shooter for record plus sighters
- Breech Safety Flag
- Rifle sling (optional)
- Shooting Mat (optional)
- Stripper Clips (optional)

Shooters are split into two relays. Relay 1 shoots first, Relay 2 goes to the pits, sets up targets from the shed, keeps score for Relay 1.

Relay 2 then shoots, Relay 1 goes to the pits, keeps score for Relay 2, then returns targets to the shed.

Squadding is done at approximately 8:00 first sighting shots down range at 8:30

Course of Fire:

This is a team competition. Single shooters are paired with other single shooters. Maximum 128 rounds per team for record.

- Five minutes of unlimited sighters, single load only
- 600 yd stage: prone from 300 yds, targets go up for 50 seconds. Shoot as many rounds as possible. Scoring is hit or miss on target silhouette.
- 500 yd stage: same as 600 yd, but with 500 yd target
- 300 yd stage: same as 600 yd and 500 yd except sitting at 300 yds
- 200 yd stage: with safety flags in breech, we walk to 200 yd line and shoot offhand (standing) again targets go up for 50 seconds.
- With safety flags in breech we walk back to 300 yd line, case all rifles and police brass.
- Trophy for both members of highest scoring team.
