

Factory Class Benchrest Match @ 100 Yards

No classification or affiliation required

Equipment Required

- Any caliber production type rifle w/any power scope
- Front & rear pedestal & sandbag rest or front bi-pod & any sand bag rear rest
- About 20 rounds of safe ammo
- Eye protection
- Ear protection
- Adjustable height stool (optional)

Time

Arrive by 8-8:30AM to register. Shooting begins@ 9:00AM **Do NOT Call the Range**

Twenty minutes are allowed to shoot 2-5 bull targets (one shot per bull) plus unlimited sighters to be fired at any time.

Match Description

Two 6 bull targets will be hanging & retrieved by volunteers - 1 bull each target is a sighter.

You will fire one shot at each record bull attempting to hit a 1/2" ten ring.

A perfect numerical score is 100.

X count is used to break ties. The X is a 1/16" dot in the center of the 10 ring.

Rifles must be cased when brought to the bench & uncased there. The reverse is true when leaving.

No equipment on the bench may be handled during cease fire periods.

Shooters **MUST** obey all range officer commands.

Awards are made; depending on the number of participants, but never exceeding top 3 places; at the end of the days shooting/scoring.

- Any rifle; any caliber; used as a single shot & in compliance with International Benchrest Shooters Assn. rules. Go to www.Internationalbenchrest.com. Click on downloads & ref to pg 17 of the rule book.
- Front & rear pedestal & sandbag rest or front bi-pod & any sand bag rear rest
- About 50 rounds of safe ammo
- Eye protection
- Ear protection
- Adjustable height stool (optional)

Course of Fire

You will shoot five groups of 5 shots each in three separate trips to the bench. Sequence 1-2-2 groups. The groups will be measured center to center of the widest two shots to .001 inch. The smallest average group size is the winner.

Time Do NOT Call the Range

Arrive by 9:00AM. Shooting begins c.10:00AM following completion of Factory Class.

First group 10 minutes second & third groups - 14 minutes, fourth & fifth groups 14 minutes.

Match Description

One target sheet (showing your name, relay & bench assignment) will be hung & retrieved by volunteers. This target has 10 separate aiming points located as 5 on top & 5 directly below.

The top aiming points are for record firing, bottom aiming points are sighters which may be fired upon at any time during the firing time limit.

Object: Shoot the tightest 5 shot cluster each of 5 times.

Rifles must be cased when brought to the bench & uncased there. The reverse is true when leaving.

No equipment on the bench may be handled during cease fire periods, especially firearms.

Shooters **MUST** obey all range officer commands.

Awards are made; depending on the number of participants, but never exceeding top 3 places; at the end of the days shooting/scoring.
