ARCSEA Continuing Education Unit (CEU) Policy

This policy is in effect for all renewals after January 1, 2016

To keep your ARCSEA professional designation you must attain Continuing Education Units yearly and upload them to your ARCSEA profile under "Professional Development"

Teaching

1 CEU = 4 Hours of teaching

If you teach a course covering an Eligible Continuing Education Topic, you may receive 0.25 CEUs per 1 hour of class taught. For example, if you teach a 4-hour class, it is equal to 1 CEU.

Learning

ARCSEA & Approved Educational Provider Workshops & Webinars

1 CEU = 1 Hour of Instruction

If you attend an ARCSEA workshop, webinar, or a class by an ARCSEA Approved Educational Provider covering an Eligible Continuing Education Topic then you receive 1 CEU per 1 hour of instruction.

CA Workshop = 6 CEUs

AP Workshop = 13 CEUs

D&C Workshop = 13 CEUs

IS Workshop = 4 CEUs

Santa Fe Community College Class = 13 CEUs

ARCSA Conference = 11-13 CEUs

Gaia College, "Rainwater Harvesting and Management" = 13CEUs

ARCSA & Approved Educational Provider Articles

0.5 CEUs = 1 Document read

If you read one of the ARCSA approved documents covering an Eligible Continuing Education Topic and listed in our store then you receive 0.5 CEUs per document.

ARCSA Instructors will earn 4 CEU's a year if they do at least one workshop presentation and participate in Instructor Meetings.

ARCSA Committee members will receive 2 CEU's as long as they attend a minimum of 10 meetings per year.

Committee/Sub-Committee Chairs will receive 4 CEU's per year.

ARCSA Board members will receive 4 CEU's each year.

Non-ARCSA Educational Provider Workshops & Webinars

You may earn CEUs for your participation in workshops and webinars led by a non-ARCSA Educational Provider as long as it covers an Eligible Continuing Education Topic.

1 CEU = 5 Hours of instruction

0.5 CEUs = 1 Webinar

If you attend a workshop by a non-ARCSA Educational Provider covering an Eligible Continuing Education Topic then you receive 0.2 CEUs per 1 hour of instruction.

If you watch a prerecorded non-ARCSA webinar covering an Eligible Continuing Education Topic then you receive 0.5 CEUs per 1 webinar.

Attending or teaching manufacturer in-house workshop, webinar, seminar be eligible for 0.5 CEU per hour of attendance.

Events cannot be used after 1 year old

Other related organization Board/Committee positions on an individually approved basis (1 CEU)
