PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Located on scenic Medicine Lake, this 1983-built home's dark & dated interior was beautifully transformed blending traditional elements with a more contemporary feel. Challenged with increasing the size of the kitchen & maximizing the lake views without adding space, we used creative structural solutions to move walls & change room sizes to successfully meet our clients' goals. Features include a mix of enameled & dark stained alder cabinetry, granite & Hans Stone c. Tops, deep blue/green c. tile backsplash, white-washed red oak wood floor & stainless appliances.

The original kitchen was boxed in and structurally it was very difficult to open the walls up, but we came up with a solution and were able to take down walls and bring the natural light in. The space has a nautical feel to it as Medicine Lake peaks through the windows. The nautical theme is seen throughout the cabinetry to the white washed flooring to the portal windows. The kitchen can now be accessed from the dining room and is completely open to the living room.

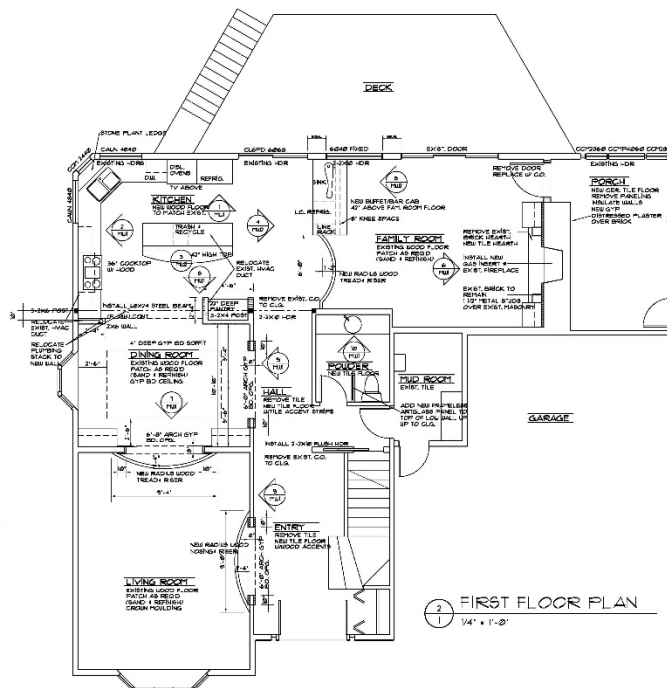
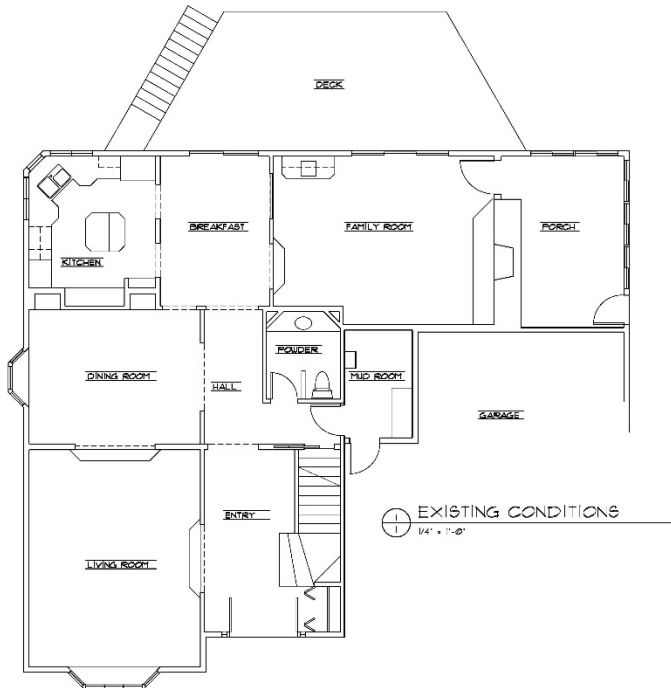
The remodeled dining room features a corrugated metal looking ceiling. The ceiling is somewhat reflective and adds another level of detail and allure. These features can be seen all over the remodeled main level. As seen in the powder bath, the wall as you enter has a shimmer tile that has that glamorous feel about it! Accompanied by the custom glass panel this powder bath is amazing all on its own!

The clients wanted a bar space off the kitchen that could double as a prep area if the kitchen was full. Complete with curved sink and wine cooler, this bar is just the right size for entertaining and prepping.

Our clients wanted a free flowing natural feeling space that they could spend time with family and friends and look out at the lake. We renovated the space to do just that and more! The light flooring keeps the flow moving throughout and the rich alder cabinetry adds the warmth!

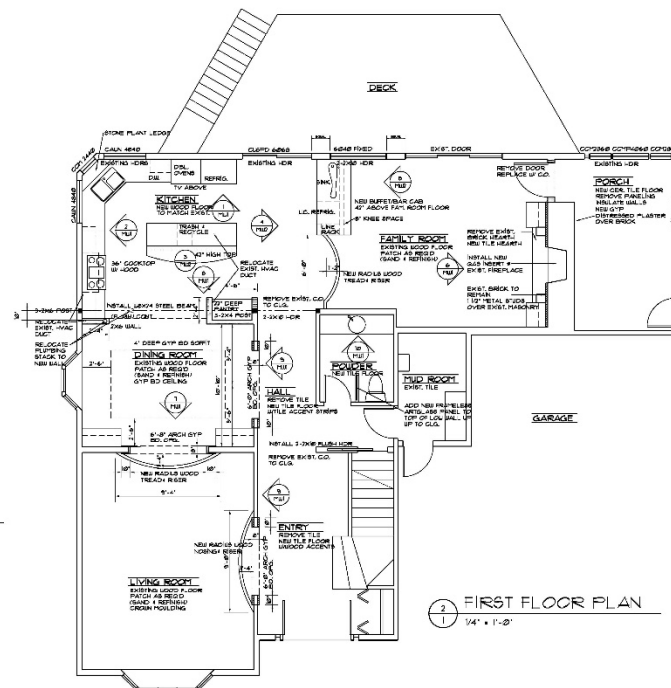
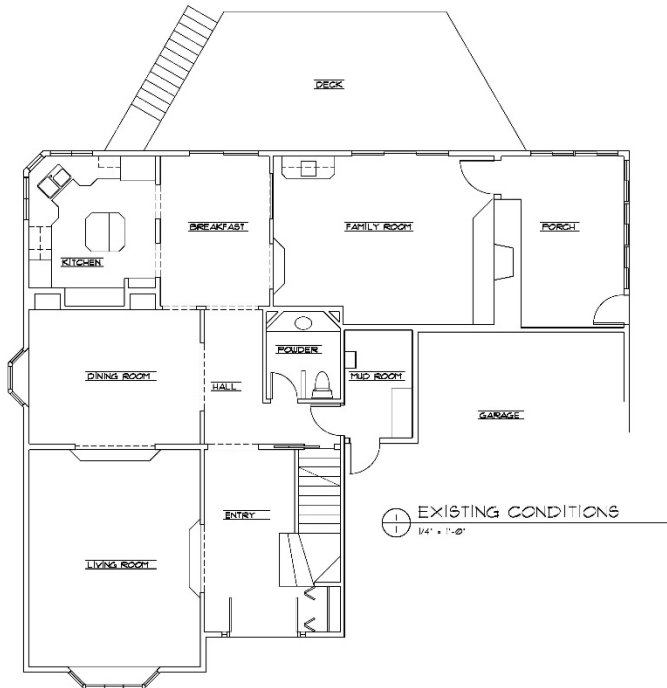
The project is seamless right down the twinkle star lights in the kitchen ceiling!
