### **Award**

The award will consist of \$1,000, a plaque, complimentary conference registration and a ticket to the annual conference dinner where the award will be presented.

### **Description**

This award will be presented annually at the CPS Annual Conference to a researcher and/or clinician who consistently exemplifies outstanding mentorship in the training of future pain researchers and/or clinicians.

### **Candidate**

A member of the Canadian Pain Society for at least 2 years who is not been a previous recipient of this award.

### **Nomination Requirements**

- a. Candidates must be nominated by at least 1 colleague or current/former trainee. The person(s) nominating and the nominee must be members of the CPS.
- b. Nominations must be made through our online form, and include the nominee's curriculum vitae and a nomination letter (max 2 pages) describing the mentorship qualities of the candidate and signed by nominee(s). *Note: All documents must be combined and uploaded in one PDF file.*
- c. The complete nomination package must be received by the CPS no later than **Monday October 31, 2016.**
- d. Selection Process: The selection will be made by a committee formed by the Canadian Pain Society.
