DESCRIPTION

The **Nursing Excellence in Pain Management Award** will be presented during the Canadian Pain Society (CPS) Annual Scientific Meeting to a CPS Nursing Issues Special Interest Group (NISIG) member who consistently exemplifies leadership in the area of nursing issues about **practice, education, and research** in pain management. The successful candidate's involvement and contributions of the CPS NISIG will also be a consideration for this award. The selection will be made by a committee formed by the Canadian Pain Society and the CPS NISIG.

AWARD

The award will consist of:

- \$200.00 honorarium
- Plaque
- Complimentary Awards Gala dinner ticket where the award will be presented

SUBMISSION CRITERIA

- Nominees must be CPS NISIG members for at least the last three years
- Candidates must be nominated by two colleagues (one must be a CPS-NISIG member)
- Nomination letter (max 2 pages) describing the leadership qualities in pain management of the candidate
- Nominee's curriculum vitae

SELECTION

Candidates will be ranked based on demonstrated leadership in an area or areas of nursing issues pertaining to practice, education or research in pain management. Examples may include:

- *Scholarly activities* relating to conduct, dissemination of research findings, publications, presentations
- *Mentorship* of nursing of interprofessional students in pain management
- *Leadership* in local, regional, provincial, national and/or international nursing or health care forums
- *Impact* on knowledge utilization and clinical practice change
