DESCRIPTION

The Canadian Pain Society (CPS) and the Canadian Pain Coalition (CPC) present the **Pain Awareness Award** to the candidate with the Best Pain Awareness Project. The goals of the award are to raise awareness of the problem of undermanaged pain in Canada, to highlight efforts towards finding solutions to the problem, and to reach a wide Canadian audience.

AWARD

The award will consist of:

- \$250.00 honorarium
- Plaque
- Complimentary Three (3) Day Scientific Meeting registration
- Complimentary Awards Gala dinner ticket where the award will be presented

SUBMISSION CRITERIA

- 1 page brief description of candidate project, including impact on target audience (max 1 page)
- Projects involving the electronic or printed media, visual, fine arts, dance, music or other creative expressions will be considered. If you wish to submit an extra item to support the project (e.g. DVD, CD, book) please send (3) copies. Collaborations among applicants from different backgrounds and disciplines are preferred. This might include projects combining the sciences and the arts or collaborations between persons living with pain and health care providers. The CPS and CPC encourage projects using several forms of expression and group submissions.
- The recipient will be invited to present their project at the Annual Scientific Meeting in 2018. Once an applicant has been selected they will be notified by email. The format of the presentation (e.g. poster, concurrent session, display table) will be determined by the awardee in collaboration with the Scientific Program Committee. The CPS and CPC will seek permissions to reproduce the work to continue raising awareness.

FORMAT

All documents must be combined and uploaded into one PDF file. Files cannot exceed 30 MB.
