- Name, contact information, phone, email
- Title of Project
- If in training, please name your Preceptor/Director
- Summary or abstract of the research project scope and hypothesis (under 40 words)
- Explain the existing research and current state of the arts in your field of research and provide reference as needed (under 100 words)
- Outline your research plan in detail, including study design and projected data analysis
- Provide an overall budget (Under 40 words)
- Financial disclosure
- Additional information in support of your project and grant application (max 100 words)
- Physician will review an edited/blind copy, please consider hiding details that would identify your site or director in the explanation as they will be removed upon review.

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicant must be a physician or have doctorate level education (MD, DO, PhD, DDS, DMD) and be a resident or fellow in training in the United States.
- \$2000 will be awarded to each of 3 recipients
- Grants cannot be used for salaries, travel, lodging or items such as ipods, laptops, cameras, etc.
- 50% of the grant money is provided upon award and the remainder is given when CSF receives a manuscript of the project. Research must be completed within a year the grant award.
- Unused funds must be returned to CSF along with a written reason why funds were not used and/or project was not completed.

Grant recipients may be required to:

- Personally present their data at the AACS Annual Meeting, February 9-11, 2017, San Diego. (CSF provides 90-day notice to coordinate presentations).
- Give first right to publish the study to *The American Journal of Cosmetic Surgery*.
- Acknowledge AACS/CSF when publishing or presenting results of CSF/AACS funded research and notify CSF of final publishing.
- Provide permission and a current CV and photo for recognition and promotion of the grant.
