Charges:

1. By February 1, 2016, survey states to determine how they are currently registering superficial e-brachy therapy units including if they require a radiation oncologist or physicist to be in the designated operator or if they allow a dermatologist to operate the unit independently.
2. By April 1, 2016, develop guidance for registering SRT e-brachy units.
3. By May 1, 2016, write a “white paper” x-ray inspectors may use as guidance during the routine inspection of SRT e-brachy units.
