The EPS

The European Physical Society was founded 1968 to contribute to and promote the advancement of physics in Europe. The EPS provides a forum for discussion of subjects of common interest in the physics community, and organises activities on all levels to communicate the importance of physics in research, industry and education.

Through the 41 EPS Member Societies in Europe, more than 120 000 physicists support the Society in achieving these goals. The EPS is aware that there are many organisations that also contribute to the advancement of physics, and thus may wish to subscribe to the goals of the Society. They are the Associate Members.

Associate Members of EPS

The list of Associate Members is published on our website, <http://www.eps.org>, and the complete list is also published annually in the Society's bi-monthly magazine, Europhysics News. At present, the Society has about 40 Associate Members, principally research institutions.

The EPS recognises the importance of its Associate Members, and is campaigning actively to increase not only the number of Associate Members, but also their participation in EPS activities.

The Associates are represented in the EPS Executive Committee and in the EPS Council, and are encouraged to provide input into the strategy and policy of the EPS.

Membership in EPS

Staff Members of Associate Members can join EPS at the same rate as members of EPS Member Societies. This entitles them to discounted registration fees at EPS Europhysics Conferences organised by our Divisions and Groups, as well as receipt of the EPS magazine, Europhysics News, as well as access to other journals in the members' area.

Publications

Associate Members receive an agreed number of copies of Europhysics News, either at one address or sent directly to designated staff members. Membership directories and publications reports of EPS bodies such as Action Committees, Divisions etc. are also sent. Associate Members are entitled to a discount on subscriptions to EPS journals, the European Journal of Physics and EPL.

Associates who are interested in publishing an article in Europhysics News on scientific or other topics related to their industry are encouraged to do so.

Associate Members receive a discount compared to standard tariffs advertising in Europhysics News.
