EPS Poster Prize

The EPS encourages recognition of the scientific merit of early career researchers.

Grants are available to EPS Europhysics and EPS Sponsored Conferences for poster prize for researchers in the PhD phase of his/her career in recognition of an excellent poster at the conference.

The amount of each prize grant is Euro 200.

Selection procedure and criteria

- Poster Prizes must be given to PhD students (defined by student registration).
- The poster must be prepared by the student.
- The conference organisers must advertise the award as the EPS Poster Prize.

Application procedure

- Conference organisers with either the Europhysics of Sponsored Conference label may request a grant for a poster prize.
- The conference organisers are responsible for the advertising and scoring procedure for the selection of the winning poster, and the application must describe the procedure.
- Depending upon availability of grant funds available, the EPS will provide funds for the EPS poster prize.

Time Period

Applications may be made at any time, normally at least 6 months prior to the start of the conference. The decision process requires approximately 2 months.
