

Europhysics Conference Abstracts

Rules for publication

- All abstracts of all conferences or meetings **organised** by the EPS, its Divisions, Sections, Interdivisional Groups, i.e. Europhysics Conferences, should be published in Europhysics Conference Abstracts (ECA).
- The copyright of all abstracts accepted is transferred to EPS. The organisers of the conference take the necessary steps to ensure that the authors are informed that the fact of submitting an abstract includes the transmission of the copyright to EPS.
- The cover has to be printed according to a standard model which can be obtained at the EPS Secretariat. The title page and volume number of the abstracts have to be coordinated with the EPS Secretariat. The abstracts are to be supplied by the authors typewritten in A4 format, at least one page, maximum two pages, leaving a space of 2cm each at the left and right edge. They should start with the title followed by the name of the author and his or her institution. In case of several co-authors, the name of the person presenting the contribution at the conference shall be underlined. At least one postal address must be given. The list of authors should be the last item in the issue. The pagination will start with number 1 for each volume. The printed size will be A5 and a reduction of 1/3 will be effected.
- The organisers will provide the EPS Secretariat with 20 copies free of charge.
- Because of the nature of the abstracts ("preproceeding"), reference to papers in ECA will be considered normal. In case the author(s) do(es) not want it, the paper will be marked NOT FOR REFERENCE.
