ESSKA Teacher Accreditation - Criteria

To be eligible to apply for ESSKA Teacher Accreditation, the following criteria need to be fulfilled:

a. ESSKA Membership

The ESSKA Teacher must be an active (paid) ESSKA member for at least two years prior to the application.

b. Clinical Excellence

The ESSKA Teacher must:

- i. have five years of clinical practice in sports traumatology with arthroscopic surgical or arthroplasty activity.
- ii. have participated as an instructor in minimum 2 surgical-skills courses (ESSKA courses or any other courses) within arthroscopy or arthroplasty.
- iii. have specialist recognition (surgery / accident surgery / orthopaedics) (areas of advanced surgery are indicated in the application)

c. Scientific excellence

The ESSKA Teacher must have at least two publications in MEDLINE on arthroscopic or arthroplasty topics.

d. Reputation

The ESSKA Teacher application must have at least one reference from an active (paid) ESSKA Member.

e. Language

The ESSKA Teachers' spoken languages must include English.
