Welfare State, Redistribution of Property

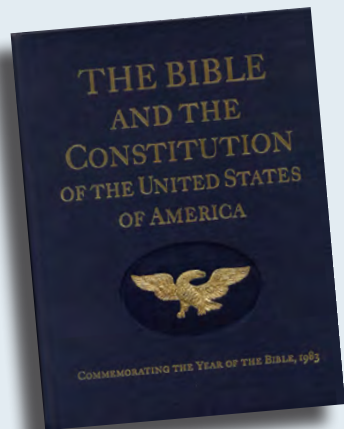
- ✦ State consents to govern all aspects/assets of life

- ✦ Socialistic democracy

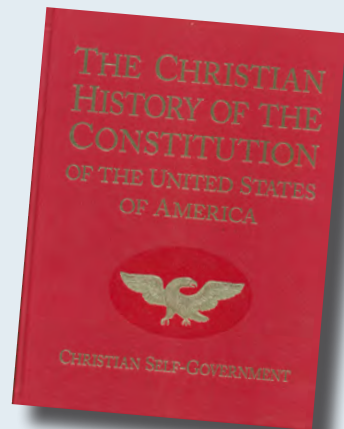
