
The purpose of the conference is to bring leaders in public financial management to address the most pressing issues and provide an update on current regulations, accounting pronouncements, auditing issues and other subjects of interest. Participants will learn about current state fiscal matters from the NJ State Treasurer and Auditor, as well as get an update on auditing, accounting and financial management issues, including the latest GASB pronouncements and governmental auditing issues. Presentations by notable speakers from the fields of government accounting, auditing and other financial management areas are featured. Prerequisites and advance preparation are not required. The conference offers 8.0 CPE credit hours for CPAs, RMAs and for Municipal and County Finance Officers: 3.0 Accounting and Auditing (Governmental), 2.0 Budgeting, 2.0 Finance and 1.0 Information Technology.
