What does my registration include?

If you are an ACA, IACP or ACVP member, your registration fee includes CE and all food functions (Welcome Reception, Fellowship Luncheon, Breakfast, Lunch, Refreshment Breaks and Celebration Dessert Reception). Does not include separate ticketed events. **Non-members** are encouraged to join ACA/IACP/ACVP prior to registering for the conference. **Upon verification of student's status** (e.g. current copy of student identification card), registration will include a free Student Membership to IACP, ACA, and ACVP. A Marketing Rep, Guest/Spouse will **not** receive CE credit with their registration.

Is there a one day registration fee?

Yes, on Saturday, February 25th. All area pharmacists and technicians are invited to attend the *New Drug Update* and *What's Going on Legislatively & Judicially? A Pharmacy Law Update* and receive up to .4 CEUs (4 contact hours). Take part in networking opportunities and walk the Exhibitor Experience.

Do I have to be a member of ACA, IACP, or ACVP to attend?

No, you may attend with or without an affiliation to the organizations.

How do you register if you are a member of more than one of the organizations?

During registration, you will have the option to choose which organization you would like to register through.

Can I attend if I am a pharmacy student?

Students are encouraged to participate in the Educational Conference. It is a wonderful way to meet with potential, future employers. Special student pricing is available!

How can I register for my NABP e-Profile ID?

Pharmacists and pharmacy technicians are now required to submit their NABP e-Profile ID and birth date to receive credit for any ACPE-accredited CPE session. The new electronic system, CPE Monitor, will

now track completed CPE credits online for pharmacists and pharmacy technicians. [Please click here to register for your NABP e-Profile ID.](#) You will be asked for your NABP e-Profile ID and birth date during the registration process to receive CE credit.

How many CE credits can I receive?

Pharmacists and technicians can receive up to 11.0 contact hours (1.1 CEUs).

Do I have to go to ACA track programming only? Or IACP or ACVP only?

No, you may rotate between tracks throughout the day. Attendees may attend any sessions they choose.

How can I receive presentation slides?

Prior to the conference, attendees will receive a link to review the presentations. The link will be available through March of 2017. Please review all presentations and share with your staff upon your return.

Will meals be provided on-site?

Yes! Each day, attendees and exhibitors will be served breakfast and lunch during the Exhibitor experiences, and on Thursday, February 23rd, attendees are invited to attend the ACA, IACP, and ACVP Fellowship Luncheon.

Should I bring my laptop?

A laptop is not required to participate in the meeting. All presentations will be available for download from the meeting website. Attendees will receive notification when the presentations are available prior to the conference. If you choose to bring a laptop, please be sure your laptop is fully charged as power outlets for each attendee will not be provided. Free Wi-Fi is not provided in the meeting room.
