IFDA is trying something different this year for OSHA Training...

With pre-registration of your firm, you will be able to access your Annual OSHA Training from the comfort and privacy of your funeral home (or wherever you choose to be). Materials for the training will be provided to you online so you can print them for all attendees from your firm prior to your audio conference.

Once you register for a specific date and time for your funeral home and indicate who from your firm will be participating, a dial-in number and access code to enter the teleconference will be given to your firm leader/attendee (the person you identify on your registration form). The leader/attendee will also receive instructions on how to download the handout.

Your firm can have as many employees gather around a speakerphone for the two hour training. The registration fee for IFDA members is \$65/line/date and attendees who require a con-ed certificate will need to pay an additional \$15/IFDA member and \$25/person for potential IFDA members.

Registration deadlines are firm (they are dictated by the audio conference provider) and no additional lines can be added after each deadline.

Cancellations:

OSHA Regulations for Funeral Directors:

The purpose of this session is to assist the funeral home owner in providing the mandated annual OSHA training to their professional staff as required under 29 CFR 1910.1030 Bloodborne Pathogens and 29 CFR 1910.1048 Formaldehyde. It is designed specifically for employees. It is the employer's responsibility to supplement this session with the following training:

- Provide employee with a copy and explanation of the employer's actual site-specific Exposure Control Plan.
- The employer's basis for selecting personal protective equipment (PPE) along with specific instructions on the use and disposal of PPE.
- Procedures to be followed and who to notify in the event of an exposure incident and a review of emergency procedures.
- The location and availability of compliance and training materials.

Finally, General Workplace Safety regulations also contain certain training requirements especially for new employees. Since this regulation does not contain specific annual training requirements, it will be mentioned, but not thoroughly covered in this session. It is the employer's responsibility to train all employees in the hazards of the workplace. The Hazard Communication Standard has phased in new requirements to comply with the Global Harmonized System, including new training requirements (2013) new SDS sheets, and new labeling (2015) and they will be covered in this course.
