You will be responsible for planning organizing, directing and managing patient safety/risk management; quality assurance/performance improvement; medical staff/medical education; professional/general liability coverages via self-insurance trust as well as all other insurance; manages litigation and claims activities in conjunction with counsel and third party claims administrators; operation of the Corporate Responsibility Program (CRP) for CHP; general legal services including contract review and drafting/preparing corporate documents and general legal support.

Position Functions:

- Maintain effectiveness of the Corporate Responsibility Program including insuring compliance with legal and regulatory requirements such as HIPAA, Stark Self-Referral Law, Anti-Kickback Statute, Hospital Licensing Act, Medicare Conditions of Participation and JCAHO.
- Overall responsibility for claims and litigation of the various self-insurance trusts as well as commercial insurance for CHP.
- Oversee hospital-wide performance improvement and quality assurance initiatives including compliance with JACHO standards.
- Provide general legal services including review, drafting/preparing legal documents, general legal advice, serve as Registered Agent for all affiliated corporations, review legal aspects of administrative policies.
