On behalf of the Board of InterPride, the International Association of Pride Organizers, and approximately 300 organizations we represent worldwide, we urge you to do everything in your power to ensure that the Rainbow Action and Korea Queer Culture Festival Organization Committee (“KQCF OC”) can proceed with their peaceful parade and rally as planned on June 28th this year. We ask you to remove the ban on outdoor rallies so that this 15 year tradition can continue.

Korea Queer Culture Festival (“KQCF”), the pride month event and Seoul Queer Parade, the pride parade in Korea, are important annual ceremonies not only for your country, but for all LGBT citizens, through the Global Pride Movement.

Additionally, we ask that you and your Police Agency serve the LGBT community of South Korea by ensuring the safety of all participants.
