Introduction



Director Development and Events delivers a host of interventions aimed at supporting the education training and development of aspiring and experienced directors.



Eligibility

An applicant must be over 21 years of age, with 1 or more years' experience as:

1. A director or alternate director of a company or
2. A company secretary of a company or
3. A senior executive or
4. A partner, associate or senior manager of a professional practice e.g. accountants, architects, stockbrokers, attorneys
5. A member of a close corporation or
6. An executive at senior level in national, provincial or local government or
7. Academic personnel at the level of, or equivalent to, Professor or senior lecturer
8. A director or equivalent position at a non-profit organisation.

Members are entitled to use the designation M.Inst.D after their name.

For example should you choose to enroll:

5 members the cost for Membership until December 2016 will total R11425.00 (inc. VAT) or

7 members the cost for Membership until December 2016 will total R14980.00 (inc. VAT)

Added benefits of group membership:

1. The discounts on the membership rates increase as the group number increases. For example the cost of 5 members through a group is the same as the cost for 4 individual memberships.
2. Through the Board Membership your organisation is able to transfer membership, i.e. should anyone currently allocated leave the organisation, you could then replace that person within the membership term.
3. Only one invoice is sent to the designated contact person so that each member does not receive sent invoices and/ or payment reminders.
