**EXEMPTION 2012-07**

Pursuant to the Proclamation of Disaster Emergency issued by the Governor on October 26, 2012, and 75 Pa. C. S. §6108, the waivers in this exemption apply to the requirements concerning the International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) for motor carriers/qualified motor vehicles traveling within or through Pennsylvania for the purpose of responding to the disaster emergency caused by Hurricane Sandy. The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation hereby issues the following exemption:

**TYPE OF OPERATION:** Motor carriers/qualified motor vehicles traveling within or through Pennsylvania for the purpose of responding to the disaster emergency caused by Hurricane Sandy, including those ensuring essential services, carrying emergency relief supplies, and providing restoration of utilities.

**EXTENT OF EXEMPTION:** All requirements concerning the International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA).

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** October 26, 2012 1500 hours.

**TERMINATION DATE:** November 26, 2012 2400 hours.

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**

1. The IFTA requirement that out-of-state motor carriers apply for and obtain a licensing permit credential known as a "Trip Permit" in accordance with Section 2102(d)(3) of the Vehicle Code, 75 Pa. C. S. §2102(d)(3), is hereby specifically waived.
