Allison works at Johns Hopkins Hospital's Sidney Kimmel Comprehensive Cancer Center as an inpatient medical oncology nurse. In December she will graduate from Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health with a Masters in Public Health and a Masters in Nursing from the Johns Hopkins University School of Nursing.

She is also working with the National Cancer Institute's Center for Global Health to address oncology nurse needs in low- and middle-income countries; she conducted a thorough educational needs-assessment and is now moving towards an international collaborative to address the needs she found.
