Tish Lancaster has worked as a cancer nurse for nearly 30 years in both clinical and management positions. For the past 17 years she has worked as the Clinical Nurse Consultant for Gynaecological Oncology at Westmead Hospital in Sydney, Australia.

She is a member of the National Executive Committee of the Cancer Nurses Society of Australia and has been a member of the Board of the International Society of Nurses in Cancer Care since 2008.

For many years she has represented cancer nurses on committees of government and non-government organisations. These currently include the Australian National Centre for Gynaecological Cancer and the ISNCC's Nominations and Awards Committee, Member Development and Communications Committee and Chair of the Knowledge Development and Dissemination Committee. She was a member of the Scientific Planning Committee for the 16th International Conference on Cancer Nursing and the Local Organising Committee for the 13th International Conference on Cancer Nursing.

Tish has participated in policy development both nationally and internationally and has given evidence at two Australian Senate Inquiries into cancer-related services. She is a Fellow of the Australian College of Nursing.
