The duties of the Editor-in-Chief will include:

- The new Editor-in-Chief will make every effort to publish and actively solicit authoritative, original and high-quality research articles in the field of pediatric diabetes and its related areas.
- He/she will take responsibility for the scientific contents of *Pediatric Diabetes*.
- He/she will have full authority to appoint an editorial board that will assist him/her in the peer review process. The general structure (Editor(s)-in-Chief, Depute Editors(s), Editorial Board Member(s)) is to be agreed between the Editor-in-Chief and the Publisher.
- He/she will supervise the processes of peer review, reviewer selection, and communication with authors.
- He/she will make every effort to ensure a rapid and efficient review of all submitted papers using a submission platform operated by Wiley.
- He/she will maintain the flow of accepted papers at a level and on a schedule for regular publication of *Pediatric Diabetes*.
- He/she will identify, select and monitor key performance indicators (KPI) by which to assess performance of the Journal and its editorial team.

Application package:

- Current curriculum vitae. Candidates for the position should:
 - Have internationally recognized standing in pediatric diabetes
 - Have a broad knowledge of the field
 - Be experienced in editorial decision making
 - Be highly skilled in editing and writing
- Evaluation of *Pediatric Diabetes*' current content, organization, appearance and policies along with recommendations for change, if any.
- Specific objectives he/she wants to achieve over the duration of his/her term.
- Strategies to increase readership, reputation, impact factor and the flow of quality manuscripts as well as published papers.
- Approach to maintaining the quality, accuracy and fairness of the review process.
