Camper Rules and Guidelines

PLEASE REVIEW THESE POLICIES FOR EACH CAMPER AND ENSURE THAT THEY READ AND UNDERSTAND THEM.

SUGGESTED ITEMS TO BRING:

Notebook, Pencil, Pen, Clothing, Hygiene Articles, Bed linens, Pillows, Quilts, Bath Towels, Swim Suit, etc.

KAPPA CAMP PROVIDES:

Meals Sunday, June 4th through Friday, June 16th, Camp T-Shirt, Lodging, all program resources needed for a successful experience.

CAMPER POLICIES

AGE LIMIT - The age limit is 12 years old thru 16 years old.

PERSONAL CONDUCT AND COURTESY - Each kamper will be responsible and accountable for their conduct at all times. We will operate with a “zero tolerance” policy in place. Lack of cooperation with the camp policies may necessitate a camper returning home early at their own expense. Kappa Camp rules prohibit the use of alcohol, conduct unbecoming of a young man which includes irreverence, disturbance of services, immodest dress, use of Profanity, use of tobacco in any form. Possessing, and weapons of any kind is prohibited. This will be strictly enforced. Do not tamper or damage camp equipment as kamper will be charged for excessive damages incurred.

MASTER’S CAMP DRESS POLICY – Guys are to dress appropriately at all times. Kamper will be required to wear shirts and shorts or appropriate athletic attire at all times with exception to Opening & Closing Ceremonies, Church Visit and Business Plan Challenge Presentation. If there are changes, we will advise the kampers prior to the event and advise on appropriate attire for each setting.

ALL CLOTHING MUST BE RESPECTFUL AND PROMOTE POSITIVE IMAGES.

Because this is a kamp and hosted on a college campus that is affiliated with Christian values, immodest, suggestive clothing, as well as clothing and caps with alcohol, tobacco, and questionable advertisements will not be allowed. If clothing is deemed inappropriate or revealing, you will be required to change. LET MODESTY BE YOUR GUIDE.

Sunday Worship - we ask that you dress nicely and respectfully. Suits, Shirts, Slacks, Ties and Dress Shoes are required.

SWIMMING - Swimming will be at scheduled times only. Positively no swimming except when lifeguard is on duty. Lifeguards retain full authority to remove any camper permanently from the pool area.

LEAVING ENCAMPMENT GROUNDS - Insurance prohibits all but emergency leaving. Permission to leave the grounds must be secured from the Camp Director only.

SCHEDULE - Scheduled activities are not optional unless specified on official schedule. Everyone is expected to attend the scheduled services, activities and recreation unless you have a completed and signed medical excuse form from the camp nurse for illness. Residence Halls will remain empty during all scheduled activities. Each activity starts at the printed time. Do not wait until printed time to leave your cabin. Do not return to your cabin during scheduled activities without a sponsor.

SPONSORS - All kampers will be assigned to a group leader that will assist them in the daily activities of Kappa Kamp. All group leaders are college age students with strong character college and exemplary attitudes. If a kamper fails to follow the directions given by their group leader, they will be sent to the Camp Director which could result in immediate dismissal. Please encourage kamper to follow all rules and policies as directed.

CAMP HOUSING - Campers agree to pay for all damages to any property. Kampers will be responsible to cover damages before they depart. In addition, if your room is not cleaned by our standards you will receive a fine of \$50 for a dirty room. All buildings and grounds must be left clean. Do not remove anything from the building.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES - No radio, TV, cassette, CD, Laser Pointers, or tape players, hand-held videogames, computer products, etc. will be allowed on the camp grounds due to past experience with breakage, theft and disturbance. (During travel you may bring a music player for entertainment purposes. These items will be secured upon arrival and returned at the end of kamp.

MEALS - Food or equipment may not be removed from the dining halls.

LAUNDRY – Laundry service will be available during the 1st weekend of Kappa Kamp (June 9-11, 2017) and it will be handled via bundle service. Please secure an appropriate laundry bag for the clothes that also has a label on it for proper handling. Bag should be able to tie or secure and all items inside will be cleaned and returned to the group leaders. The fees for the service is \$10 and can be paid upon arrival on June 5th.

CURFEW - Lights must be out according to camp schedule unless otherwise indicated by the schedule. No one is permitted outside of their room after this time. This rule is to be strictly enforced and failure to comply may necessitate camper returning home. (Because of problems in the past this rule will be enforced at a no tolerance level)
