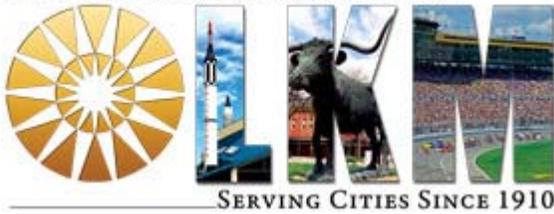

1) Register for the Free Legislative Wrap-Up Webinar

The 2015 legislative session, the longest in our state's history, concluded on June 26. The legislature passed a number of laws that will dramatically affect local governments, including changing election days, imposing a tax lid, and many others. 5) Opportunity to Comment on Salary Threshold for Exempt Employees

Last week, President Obama proposed a rule change that would raise the exempt employee threshold salary from \$455 a week (the equivalent of \$23,660 a year) to \$970 a week (\$50,440 a year) in 2016. This would mean that employees who are currently treated as exempt, who continue to make less than \$50,440 in 2016, would no longer qualify as exempt, and would be eligible for overtime pay.
