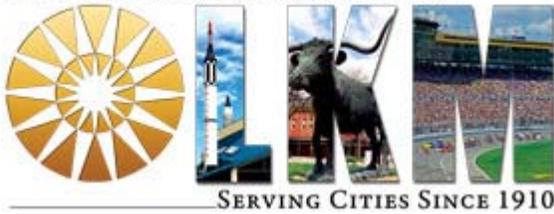

### 5) League Seeking Individuals for Appointment to 911 Coordinating Council

The League is accepting names for consideration for appointment to the 911 Coordinating Council. The *911 ACT* created a 911 Coordinating Council (Council) comprised of 26 members. Twenty-two members are appointed by the governor and four legislators are appointed by their leadership. The Council has broad statutory responsibilities that include monitoring the delivery of 911 services, developing strategies for future enhancements to the 911 system, distributing 911 grant funds, adopting administrative regulations, selecting the Local Collection Point Administrator, and providing guidance to Public Safety Answering Points (PSAPs).

If you wish to serve on the Council, an email detailing your interest and relevant experience should be sent to the League no later than Wednesday, January 13, 2016. Technical knowledge involving geographic information systems (GIS) and/or

telecommunications is beneficial. Please send correspondence to Erik Satorius with the subject "911 Coordinating Council Appointment: [NAME] and [CITY]."
