The Convention of Voting Delegates also selected three governing body members to continue in their current positions for an additional, three-year term: J. Michael Wilkes, City Manager, City of Olathe; Mark Holland, Mayor & CEO, Unified Government of Wyandotte County and Kansas City, KS; and Kelli Hansen, Mayor, City of Plainville.
