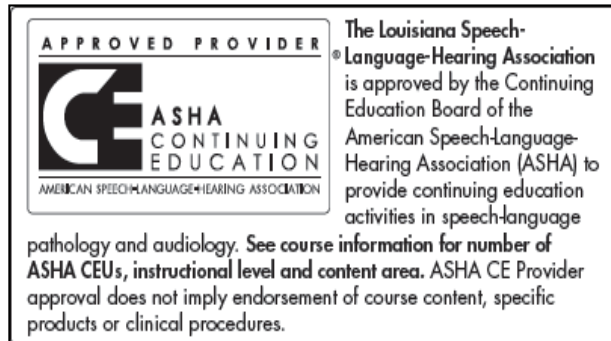


Registration Fees

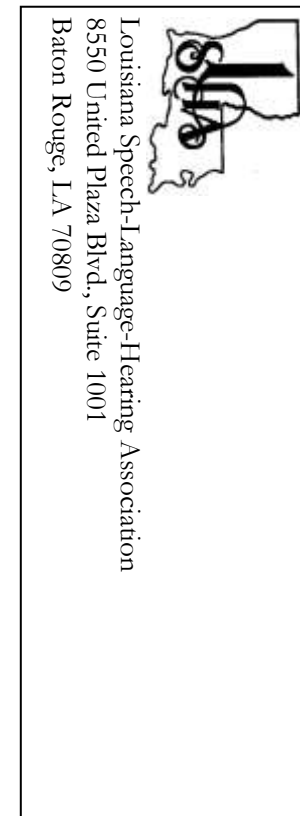
Theresa H Rodgers, M.A., EdSp, L-SLP, CCC-SLP
