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APPLICATION FOR RETIRED MEMBER STATUS

Article 2 – Section 2.10A Retired Member:

Designated Members in good standing may apply for Retired Member Status under either of the following conditions:

1. A minimum age of sixty-five (65). Proof is required by presentation of a certified copy of a birth certificate or other equivalent document.
2. A notarized copy of a medical report signed by a licensed physician and stating that a permanent disability exists and its nature.

Application for Retired Member Status shall be submitted on a standard form to be furnished by the national office. The application must be approved in the following order:

1. Chapter President
2. State Director
3. Two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Board

Upon approval the retired member shall, by paying a nominal amount (\$125.00), set by the Board, receive all publications sent to active members. The retired member will not be eligible to hold office in the association but may continue to attend meetings and use any earned designation modified by the term “Retired” such as John M. Smith, IFAS (Ret).

Retired members shall not perform appraisals. They may only apply for reinstatement to regular status by paying all back dues and applying through the Chapter President and the State Director to the Board. The Board may approve said reinstatement by a two-thirds (2/3) vote. Retired members are subject to the same Code of Ethics as are active members. The Board may revise back dues payment requirement under extenuating circumstances.
