

IFAA Designation Requirements

Good Moral Character	Applicant must submit the appropriate fee and a completed and signed Experience Rating Form (ERF) with signature of chapter officer or State Director and two letters of recommendation
Membership Standing	Must be a current Member in Good Standing
Standards and Ethics	Applicant must submit proof of completion of the 15 hour National USPAP course and must complete ERF with signature agreeing to abide by the NAIFA Code of Ethics.
Required Course Work	Must meet the current AQB requirements for Certified General. If applicant is a current Certified General Appraiser required course work is considered to have been met.
Comprehensive Exam	An applicant must pass either the AQB <i>National Uniform Licensing and Certification Examinations-General</i> or the NAIFA comprehensive exam. An applicant that is currently State Certified General is considered to have met this requirement.
College Degree Requirement	Applicant must meet the current Certified General AQB requirements. Applicant that is State Certified General has met this requirement.
Appraisal Experience	<p>Provide evidence of 6,000 hours of income property/non-residential appraisal experience accomplished in the past 4 years; 3,000 hours must be in the appraisal of agricultural properties.</p> <p>Provide evidence of acceptable competence in performing Agriculture appraisals in the normal course of business. Applicant to provide list of Agriculture assignments completed over prior one year</p>
Demonstration Report	Submit a Demonstration Self-Contained Appraisal Report , of an agricultural property, subject to the requirements and grading criteria set forth by the Admissions Committee. This report must be submitted in a portable document format (PDF).
