HELP USA is one of the nation's largest homeless service providers and low-income housing developers serving at-risk populations including families, veterans, and survivors of domestic violence.

With an annual operating budget in excess of \$100 million, HELP USA currently serves 25,000 people per year in 52 programs and residences across five states and is continuing to grow. HELP provides 3,500 units of permanent and transitional housing as part of its 30-year commitment to families and individuals in need of safe, stable homes.

Position Overview

HELP USA is seeking several LCSWs for Family and Day Care Services sites in northern Manhattan and the Bronx. LCSWs lead and supervise the Client Care Coordination program team at their site and are responsible for ensuring day to day operation of the program, reporting to the site's Executive Director. As needed, they also function as Client Care Coordinators, including coordination of services for an assigned caseload of clients.

Requirements

Candidates must be licensed as an LCSW. They should be creative, have experience with group work, and have strong supervisory skills. Experience working with homeless populations or issues typical of this group would be strongly preferred. Candidates should be proficient with Microsoft Office and have the ability to maintain statistics using various programs.

Compensation

This position offers a highly competitive starting salary of \$70,000, a good benefits package, and an opportunity for advancement as the organization continues to expand.
