ICE 7 (3/20-22/2017) was focused on testing three related, but distinct areas. These areas were external applications, additional data and Emergency Incident Data Document (EIDD) interoperability testing.

#### **EVENT FIRSTS**

Testing of multiple participants' external applications, similar to the type that will allow the public to transmit improved location information.

Testing the transmittal of additional data from the public, and from the call taker or other sources to improve the flow of critical information.

Testing the exchange of structured EIDDs. These information and data exchanges support an improved method of interoperability between PSAPs and other types of public safety entities.

#### **LESSONS LEARNED**

External applications on user devices can be fully processed by the NGCS platforms defined in the i3 recommended standard.

Additional data may be available from multiple sources, and injected into the NGCS core at multiple ingress points.
