Agree to comply with NMVMA Bylaws, Policies and The AVMA Principles of Veterinary Medical Ethics

Non-Resident Member \$92.50 (\$107.50 after August 1)

Veterinarians residing in states other than New Mexico. Non-Resident members shall not be entitled to vote or to hold office, but shall enjoy all other privileges of NMVMA membership

Senior Member \$145 (\$169 after August 1)

Any NMVMA member who has been a regular member of the association for at
