TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Application Deadlines: Participant is advised to retain a copy of this application and any accompanying documentation submitted. **Complete applications must be submitted during the same calendar year of the equipment purchase and no later than 180 days from the equipment purchase date.** Neither Energy Trust nor its representatives will be responsible for any lost documentation pertaining to this application, or any lost or misdirected mail.

Eligibility: Program incentives are available to eligible industrial, municipal and agricultural customers of NW Natural or Cascade Natural Gas in Oregon. In order to qualify for incentives, the equipment purchased must: (i) meet the required efficiency standards as set forth in this application, (ii) be installed at the facility address listed, and (iii) be purchased/installed during the same calendar year that this incentive application is submitted and within the 180 day deadline. Final determination of eligibility rests solely with Energy Trust.

Incentives: Funds for incentives are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis. Details of the Program, including incentive levels, are subject to change. The total incentive provided (i) will depend upon the incentive amounts in effect as of the equipment purchase date, and (ii) will never exceed the total project cost. Limited to one incentive per one equipment purchase.

Payment: Incentives will be paid upon: (i) submission of this completed application along with all required accompanying proof of purchase documentation, and (ii) satisfactory completion of a verification inspection, if required. Please allow 60 to 90 days from the Energy Trust's receipt of all information for delivery of payment. Failure to deliver all required documentation may result in delay or withholding of payment.

Proof of Purchase: Participant must submit all sales receipts, invoices, manufacturer specification sheets, and other pertinent documents itemizing the equipment purchased. The proof of purchase documentation submitted must show: (i) the date of purchase and itemized price paid, and (ii) size, type, make, and model or part number of equipment purchased. Participant will provide Energy Trust with additional proof of purchase information upon request.

Verification: Equipment installations may be selected for an on-site installation verification inspection. Should a Participant's facility be chosen for a verification inspection, satisfactory completion of that inspection must occur before payment will be issued. This inspection is for the purpose of incentive payment only. No warranty is implied.

No Endorsement: Energy Trust and its representatives do not endorse any particular manufacturer, contractor or product in promoting the Program. The fact that the names of particular manufacturers, contractors, products, or systems may appear on this application does not constitute an endorsement. Facsimile/Scanned Signatures: Facsimile transmission of an original document or an electronically transmitted scan of an original document shall be regarded as equivalent to the physical delivery of the original signed document. Upon request, Participant shall confirm document transmission by facsimile or electronic transfer by providing an original document.

Natural Gas Non-Transportation Agreement: The incentive funding available for natural gas energy efficiency measures, for Northwest Natural Gas Company (NW Natural) Sales Customers served on Industrial Rate Schedule 3, 31 or 32, or Commercial Rate Schedule 32, is subject to NW Natural's Schedule 360 filing with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon. Customers with transportation service are not eligible for natural gas incentives.

NW Natural's approved Schedule 360 provides that, effective as of September 8, 2010, NW Natural may require customers on one of the identified rate schedules who receive Energy Trust natural gas incentive funds to payback a prorated amount of the incentives received if they decide to transfer from sales to transportation within 2 years from the date the incentive was issued. The calculation of the prorated amount is determined as follows: Charge = Original incentive amount * (24 - the # months since the incentive was issued) / 24. The Schedule 360 also states that (i) a charge will not be assessed when the total incentive amounts received by such customer are \$25,000 or less; and that (ii) when applicable, the charge must be paid in full as a condition of NW Natural's approval to change service type. Additional details about this charge can be obtained in NW Natural's Schedule 360 (Industrial DSM Programs) filing with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon or by contacting NW Natural.

Participant understands and agrees (i) to notify Energy Trust at the same time as it provides any notice to NW Natural requesting a change to a transportation service type for the site account(s) identified herein; and (ii) that Energy Trust will report information to NW Natural regarding the natural gas energy efficiency measures at this site and associated Energy Trust services and incentives provided.
