

**Harald zur Hausen, M.D.**

Dr. zur Hausen received his M.D. in 1960 in Germany and worked subsequently in the Institutes of Virology in Duesseldorf, Germany, Philadelphia, PA, USA, and Wuerzburg, Germany. In 1972 he was named Chairman of the Department of Virology, University Erlangen-Nuernberg, and was subsequently named to the same position at the University of Freiburg.



From 1983 to 2003 he served as Scientific Director of the German Cancer Research Center (DKFZ) in Heidelberg. Dr. zur Hausen received a number of national and international awards, including the Robert-Koch-Price, Paul-Ehrlich-Price, Charles S. Mott Price of the General Motors Cancer Research Foundation, Charles R. Brupbacher Price Zuerich. Several honorary doctorates were awarded to him: from the Universities of Chicago, USA; Umea, Sweden; Prague, Czech Republic; Salford, UK; and Helsinki, Finland.

Dr. zur Hausen is an elected member of various academies and research organizations, including the Institute of Medicine of the US National Academy of Sciences, American Philosophical Society, German Academy LEOPOLDINA, European Molecular Biology Organization (EMBO). Dr. zur Hausen is author or co-author of 270 papers in international journals.
