TRANSPORTATION

ALL STUDENTS MUST USE TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED BY ST. FRANCIS.

TICKET SALES: APRIL 24 – MAY 1

Price \$100 per person; \$200 per couple

Tickets will be sold in the Student Union during C & E lunch; only Juniors and Seniors may purchase tickets. The enclosed Prom Parent Information sheet must also be signed and handed in when purchasing Prom tickets. Signed forms are required for both the ticket purchaser and the date. Personal checks will be accepted but please no credit cards.

GUEST POLICY:

If a Junior or Senior would like to bring a guest who is not a student at St. Francis, the proper guest request form must be completed and handed in to the Dean's office prior to purchasing tickets. Guest Request forms are due **by 8am April 28. NO EXCEPTIONS.** Copies of the form are available in Student Services or may be downloaded from the St. Francis website under the "School Forms" tab.

ATTENDANCE POLICY:

All students attending Prom must be in full attendance on Friday, May 5th.

STUDENT GUIDELINES and DRESS CODE

Students attending Prom are required to comply with all St. Francis HS policies and procedures including:

No selling of, using of, possession of, or being under the influence of alcohol and/or any other drugs.

No smoking at Prom, on the premises of the Museum of Science and Industry or on the buses.

If your date is not a St. Francis student, you are responsible for informing him/her of these regulations. (All regulations hold regardless of your date's age.)

As required by bus and public facility policies, students in possession of, or under the influence of, alcohol or other drugs will forfeit their ticket and are subject to arrest by the proper authorities.

Bags may be hand searched at the discretion of the chaperones.

Anyone suspected of being in violation of these regulations prior to Prom will not be admitted to the Prom. If a violation of these regulations occurs during Prom, your parents will be called and they will be required to pick you up.

Be sure to follow the proper dress requirements as outlined in terms of dresses and appropriate attire. Anyone who is deemed inappropriate will not come to the event. According to the rules of the museum, please be advised that you must have shoes on at all times!! Be prepared to bring a change of shoes if necessary. As you are shopping for your daughter's prom dress, remember to check whether she can sit, walk, and dance in the dress. The dress should be of an age-appropriate length and cut; cutouts in the dress are not permitted. The dresses must completely cover from side seam to side seam. The back must not go lower than the natural waist. Two-piece dresses are not permitted. Remember, the dance is a lot more fun when the dress fits comfortably.

Anyone in violation of the dress regulations will be wearing their date's jacket for the evening and serving a Saturday detention.
