



## SIM IT Trends Study Finds IT’s Head in the Cloud

This year’s IT Trends Study finds **Cloud Computing becoming a larger and more important part of IT in organizations**. Ranked as the **4<sup>th</sup> largest IT investment** this year (up from 7<sup>th</sup> in 2015), 801 participating SIM members ranked it **3<sup>rd</sup> as a technology that should get even more investment dollars**, and their **4<sup>th</sup> most personally worrisome technology**.

On top of that, **89.7% of organizations increased their Cloud usage this year** and the **percentage of all IT services delivered via the cloud grew from 27.2% in 2015 to 31.9%**. The **Cloud is also having a significant impact on IT budgets**. Overall IT spending increased about 4.1% this year, so **the increase in cloud spending is coming at the expense of other categories, especially hardware and software** (see table below). Predictions are for **cloud spending to increase more than 25% in 2017, with less money going to every other IT spending category next year except employees** (which is flat).
