### who is eligible?

- Equity actors who retain their status through February 28, 2017 automatically qualify per AEA regulations.
  - Non-Equity actors (including those who attended General Auditions in 2016) can apply for the weighted lottery that selects this year's participants if they meet the following criteria:
    - Must be yearly members\* of Theatre Bay Area through February 28, 2017 AND
    - Must have at least one year of full-time acting training (or equivalent part-time study) OR at least six stage productions apart from school.
- \* Monthly members are not eligible to apply. Contact us to upgrade your membership.

Apply online at [TheatreBayArea.org](http://TheatreBayArea.org) OR send application, two headshots, two copies of your resume (must reflect your eligibility) and proof of AEA status (if applicable) to: TBA General Auditions, 1119 Market Street, 2nd Floor, San Francisco, CA 94103.

**RECEIPT DEADLINE: DECEMBER 19, 2016; 5PM**

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. All eligible actors who do not get a slot will have their resumes and headshots available to the auditors for review during the Generals. Up to three actors who both complete the training and submit an artist's career map will be chosen to receive \$1,000 to help make that plan a reality. Titan winners will receive a year-long mentorship and other great career boosters.
