### Greg Lindsay

Journalist, Urbanist, Futurist, Speaker



Greg Lindsay is a journalist, urbanist, futurist, and speaker. He is a contributing writer for Fast Company, author of the forthcoming book *Engineering Serendipity*, and co-author of *Aerotropolis: The Way We'll Live Next*. He is also a senior fellow of the New Cities Foundation — where he leads the Connected Mobility Initiative — a non-resident senior fellow of The Atlantic Council's Strategic Foresight Initiative, a visiting scholar at New York University's Rudin Center for Transportation Policy & Management, and a senior fellow of the World Policy Institute.

Greg speaks frequently about globalization, innovation, and the future of cities, most recently at Microsoft Research, McKinsey, the U.S. State Department, the Canada Council for the Arts, and the Venice Architecture Biennale. He is a term member of the Council on Foreign Relations and a Young Leader of the World Cities Summit. His work with Studio Gang Architects on the future of suburbia was displayed at New York's Museum of Modern Art in 2012.

His writing has appeared in *The New York Times*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *Bloomberg BusinessWeek*, *Harvard Business Review*, *Travel + Leisure*, *Condé Nast Traveler*, and *Departures*, among many other publications. He has advised Intel, Audi, Ericsson, Samsung, André Balazs Properties, and Chrysler, among other organizations.

Greg is a two-time Jeopardy! champion (and the only human to go undefeated against IBM's Watson).
