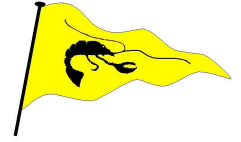

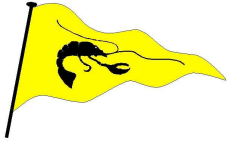
Notice of Race

Buzz Open Blaze, Halo, Fire, Traveller Series RS 400 Southern Tour Saturday, Sunday 16/17 July 2016

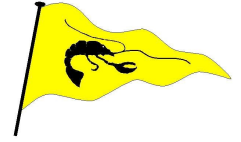
1. **Organising Authority:** Warsash Sailing Club.
2. **Rules:** Racing will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2012-2016, the Prescriptions of the RYA, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions issued for this event and the Class Rules. In the event of a conflict, the Sailing Instructions shall take precedence.
3. **RYA Racing Charter:** Competitors should note that Warsash Sailing Club as the organising authority implements the RYA Racing Charter and that all competitors are required to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found in the RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing 2013- 2016) or at www.rya.org.uk/racing/charter
4. **Advertising:** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.
5. **Eligibility:** The event is open to all paid up members of the relevant Class Association and international associations
6. **Entry fee:** The entry fee for the event is £40 for the RS 400 and Buzz fleet and £35 for the Blazes, Halo and Fire. Entries completed by the 15th June will receive a £10 Discount.
7. **Registration:** Registration will be from 09.00 on Saturday 16th July in the Main Hall in Shore House.
8. **Races:** There will be a maximum of 6 races. A maximum of 1 discard will be allowed. The first race will not start before 1230 on Saturday. The last race will not start after 15.00 on Sunday. The target duration of each race will be 45 minutes.
9. **Briefing:** There will be a competitors briefing at 10.30 on Saturday and 09.00 on Sunday.
10. **Sailing Instructions:** The sailing instructions will be issued at registration.
11. **Race area:** The race area will be within Southampton Water/The Solent up to 2 miles from WSC.
12. **Risk Statement:** Rule 4 of the RRS states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or continue to race is hers alone" and that sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport

and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- a. They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- b. They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- c. They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- d. Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- e. The provision of a race management team, patrol boats if any and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- f. The provision of patrol boat cover if any is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can practically be provided in the circumstances;
- g. Personal buoyancy shall be worn by all competitors whilst afloat;
- h. Their boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular, to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £3,000,000.

13. **Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded as below.

Engraved glasses will be awarded as below:

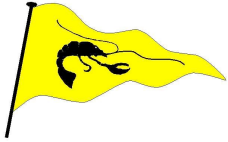
- a. **RS400 Class**
1st to 4th placed boats overall
- b. **Blaze Class**
1st to 5th placed boats overall
- c. **Halo Class**
First placed boat overall only
- d. **Fire Class**
First placed boat overall only
- e. **Buzz Class**
1st, 2nd and 3rd placed boat overall

1st to 3rd placed boats in the RS400 Class Southern Tour (Saturday racing only) will also each receive a bottle of wine

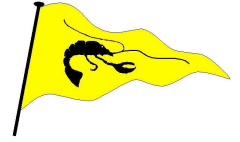
In addition other prizes may also be awarded.

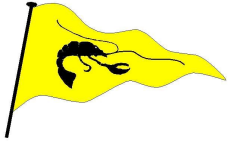
14. Social:

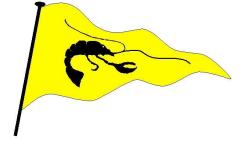
