ABAG is excited to present our *2015 Profile of Education Giving*, which aggregates data about our membership's investments in education. The *Profile* was developed in response to ABAG members' requests for information about their peers' education funding. We are pleased to be able to provide our members with this picture of the scope of education-related grantmaking across our membership and help colleagues who care about specific education issues connect with each other. As ABAG's membership grows, so does the scope of our members' grantmaking. This report includes data from several community foundations with geographic foci beyond Baltimore.

In Summer 2015, ABAG disseminated an online survey to all ABAG members. We deliberately did not define "education-related giving" in the survey, in hopes of gaining a better sense of what each member considers to be education-related grantmaking. For example, one member might consider adult education as education-related grantmaking, and would include it in their response, while another might consider it to be workforce development grantmaking and would not have included it. Please keep this in mind throughout the report. Upon request, we can provide ABAG members with more detailed data. We will not share financial information that is not publicly available.

## OVERVIEW

In 2014, ABAG members contributed more than \$49.2 million to education efforts through more than 1,000 grants to more than 475 organizations.

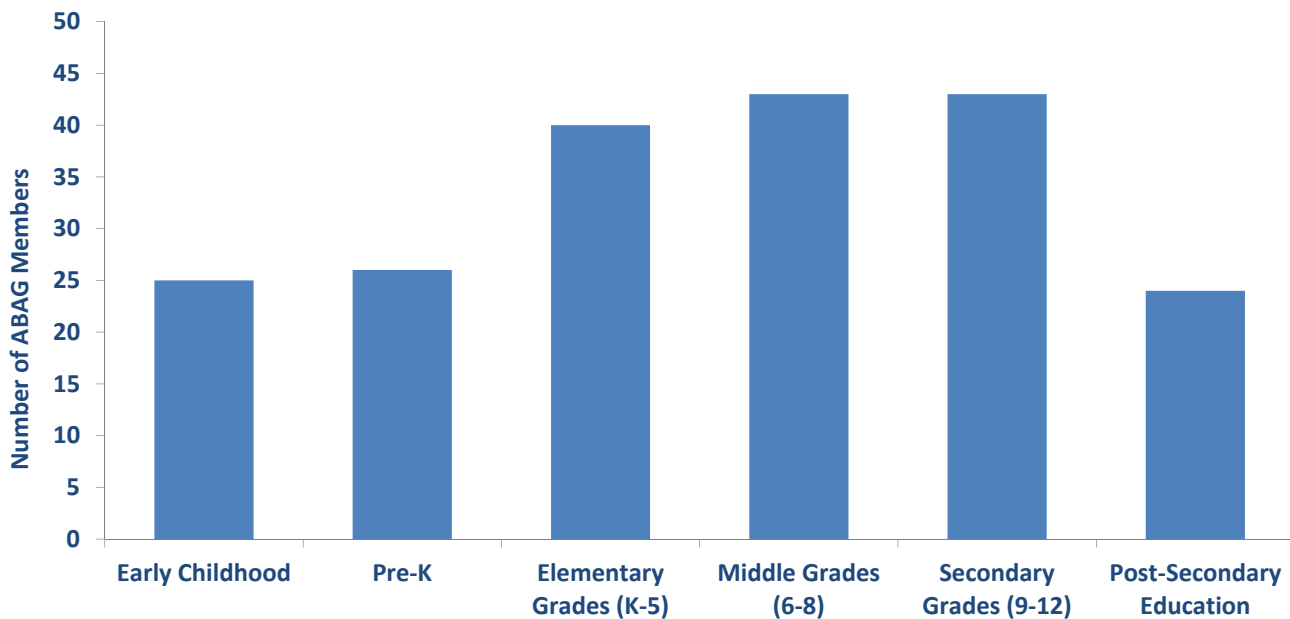

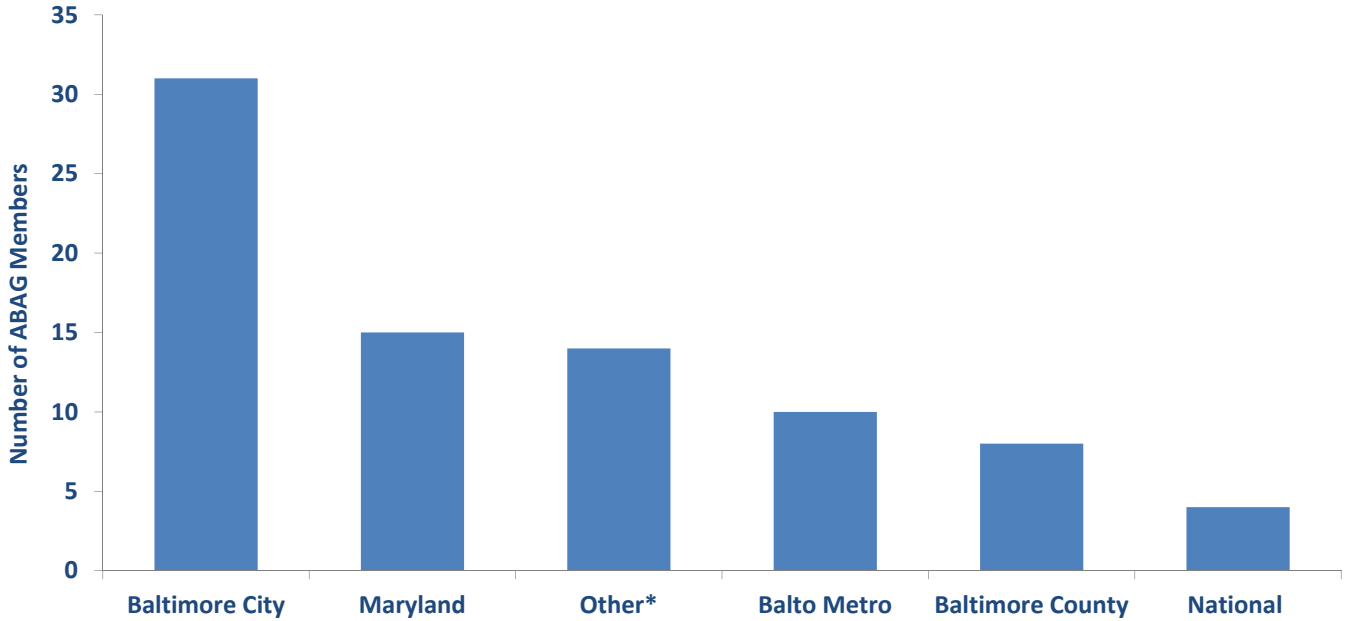
### Grantmaking by Grade Levels



Nearly half of the respondents (27 ABAG members) fund efforts toward system-wide education reform, such as advocacy work by the ACLU of Maryland.

More than half of the survey respondents' education grantmaking includes a geographic focus on Baltimore City. As ABAG's membership expands, a greater percentage of our members are making grants to geographic areas beyond Maryland (the specific locations are listed below).

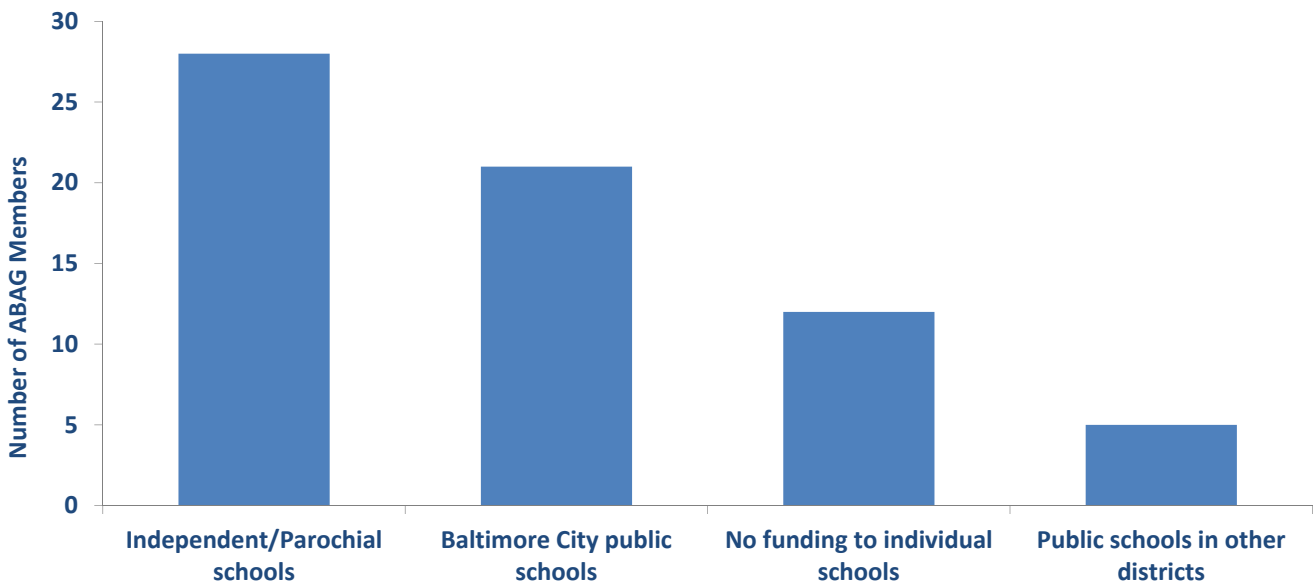
### Grantmaking by Geographic Area

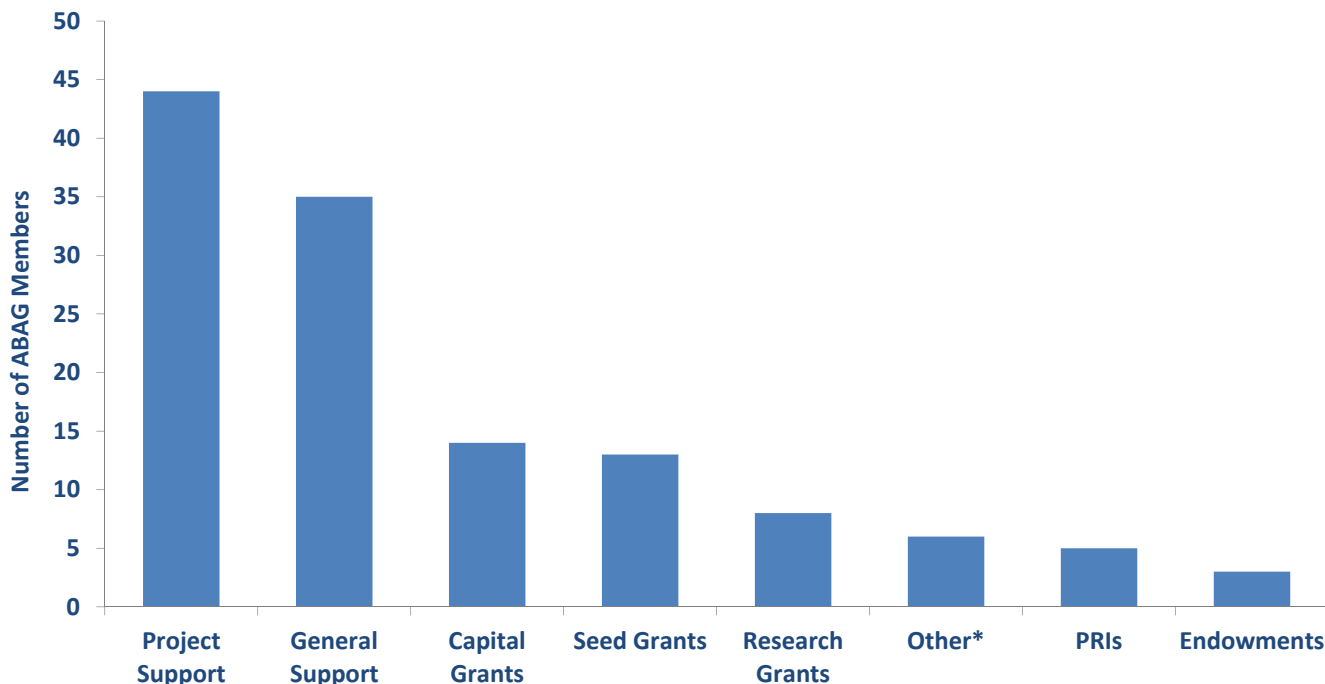

ABAG members make a variety of types of education grants. More than two-thirds make grants for specific projects and/or general support, and nearly one-third make capital and/or seed grants:

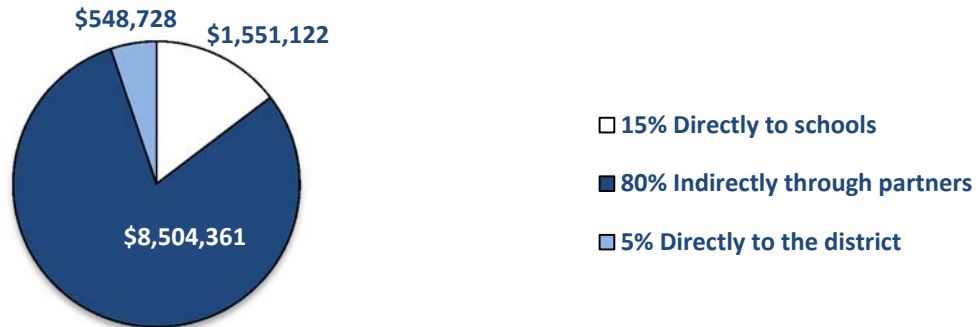
### Types of Education Grants Made



- Project Support: Grants that support a prescribed set of activities to achieve a defined projected outcome.
- General Support: Grants that can be used for the full range of the grantee's activities - the grantee determines how the funds will be used.
- Capital Grants: Grants that help meet future demands by financing purchase of land, construction of physical facilities, or similar activities.
- Seed Grants: Grants that help new organizations or programs - funds are often used for planning or feasibility studies or for the initial costs of staff and operations.
- Other: All respondents who selected "other" indicated that they provide scholarships – many other members also support scholarships, as indicated in the Higher Education section that follows
- Program-Related Investments (PRIs): PRIs leverage foundation dollars by providing low-interest loans to promote community wealth building and other mission-related foundation goals.

## SUPPORT FOR BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

In 2014, ABAG members gave more than \$10.6 million to organizations working with Baltimore City Public Schools, to individual schools, and the district itself.

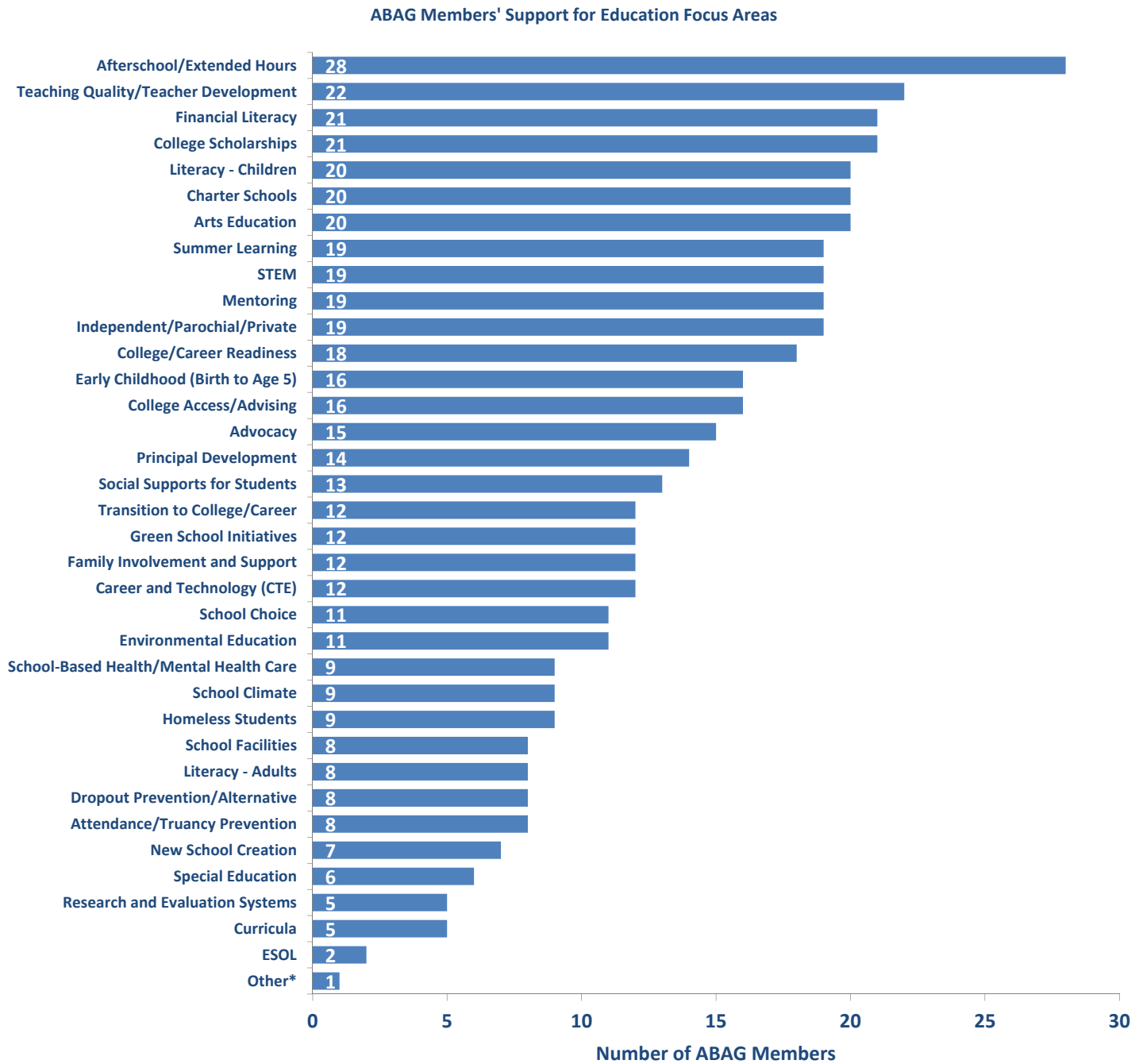
