In working with fraternities and sororities, the understanding and demonstration of these competencies will allow advisors to provide undergraduate members with positive fraternity/sorority experiences.



EDUCATOR

A fraternity/sorority advisor applies student development and/or organizational development theory to his/her practice in challenging and supporting organizations and individual members.



VALUES ALIGNER

A fraternity/sorority advisor sets & clearly communicates high expectations for chapters as values-based organizations hosted at an institution of higher education and holds members/organizations accountable for their actions.



COLLABORATOR

A fraternity/sorority advisor collaborates with and often serves as a liaison among potential and initiated members, chapter officers, campus administrators, alumni/ae, volunteer advisors, house corporations, inter/national organization staff members, and/or inter/national officers.



LEADER

A fraternity/sorority advisor is an involved, engaged member of a campus community and/or the interfraternal movement and participates in opportunities for continued professional development through the Association and other organizations.



RESEARCHER

A fraternity/sorority advisor uses research to guide practice. They assess the needs of groups, engage constituents in strategic planning to set goals for ongoing development and to provide programs and resources, and assess the impact of those initiatives.



INNOVATOR

A fraternity/sorority advisor implements new programs that benefit members.



ADVISOR

A fraternity/sorority advisor guides and facilitates the work of fraternity/sorority chapters and/or governing councils and their respective officers.



ADMINISTRATOR

A fraternity/sorority advisor maintains accurate and comprehensive records on membership statistics, scholarship achievement, and disciplinary matters.

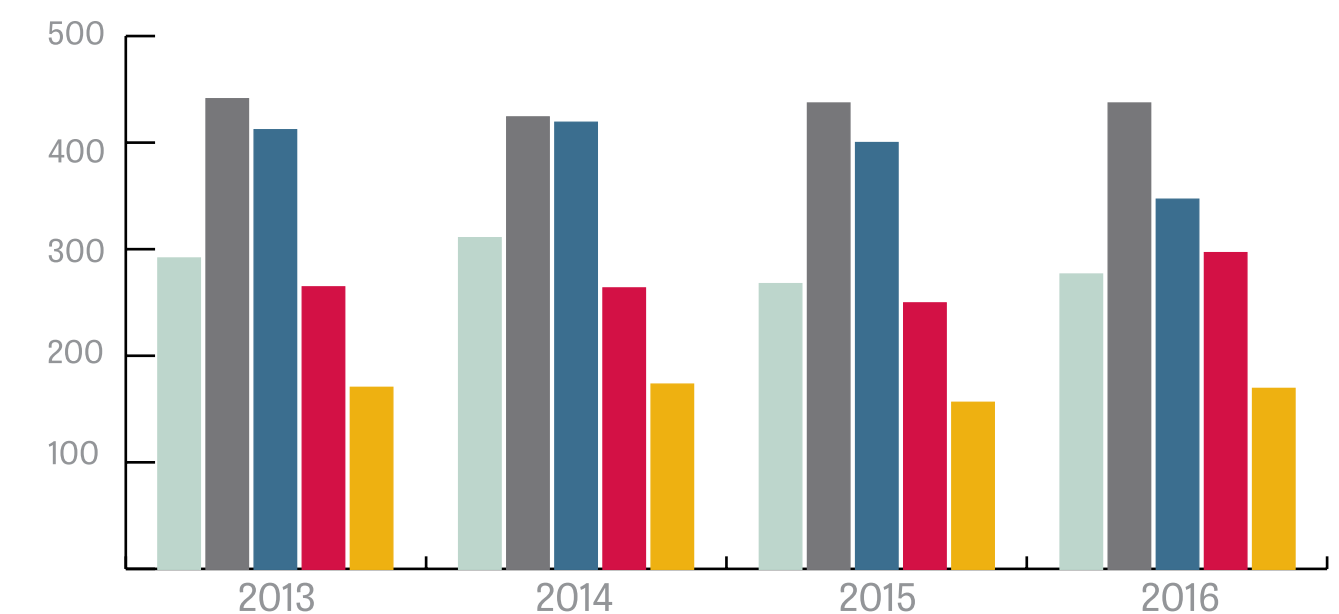

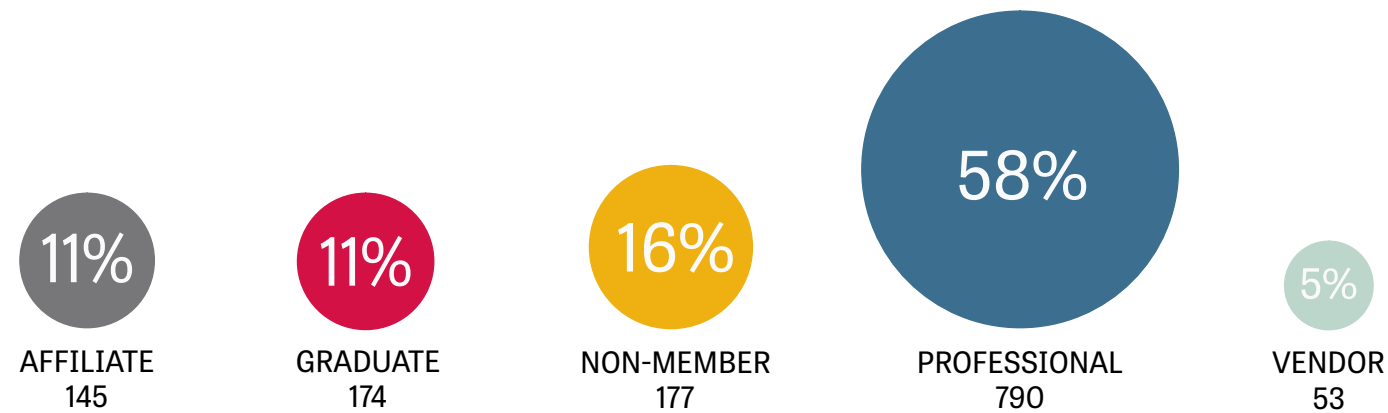

PROFESSIONALS' INSTITUTE

You're Not an Advisor Anymore: Re-positioning the Campus-Based Fraternity/Sorority Professional

The role of campus-based fraternity/sorority professionals has evolved over the past 40 years, and the markers of success are still changing. With increasing calls for measurable outcomes in higher education, fraternity/sorority professionals need to reposition themselves to remain relevant. Using recent research on the fraternity/sorority profession, the 2016 Professionals' Institute examined the contribution of fraternity/sorority professionals to institutional priorities. The session provided strategies for adapting to new measures of success, and equipped professionals to better assess the impact of membership on student outcomes. GLOBAL SERVICE TRIP

For a second year, the Association is partnered with Delta Upsilon Fraternity to sponsor a global service trip for fraternity/sorority professionals from December 12-18, 2016. Nine (9) participants spent a week in Negril, Jamaica doing service projects within the community and learning about the culture through a guided curriculum focused on global citizenship and social justice.

FIRST 90 DAYS

Sigma Chi Fraternity has given a one-time gift of \$20,000 to provide funding for the redevelopment and deployment of the First 90 Days program, with RISE Partnerships, LLC. The cohort based program, specifically designed for campus-based professionals as they begin their careers as fraternity/sorority advisors, launched in September 2015 and ran until December 2015. Forty (40) professionals completed the fall 2015 bi-weekly program. The program was facilitated by Dominic Greene, Director, Student Activities at American University & Megan Janasiewicz, Director of Fraternity and Sorority Life at Florida State University.

TITLE IX FRATERNAL & STUDENT CONDUCT INSTITUTE

In conjunction with The Association of Student Conduct Administration (ASCA) the inaugural Title IX Fraternal & Student Conduct Institute was held July 26-28, 2015 in Indianapolis, IN on the Indiana University – Purdue University Indianapolis (IUPUI) campus. The institute had 111 registered attendees. AFA and the American College Personnel Association Inc. (ACPA) also partnered on the Title IX Institute. As part of this partnership, ACPA record the presentations during the conference and the content from this Institute is available on the ACPA and AFA websites.

PERSPECTIVES

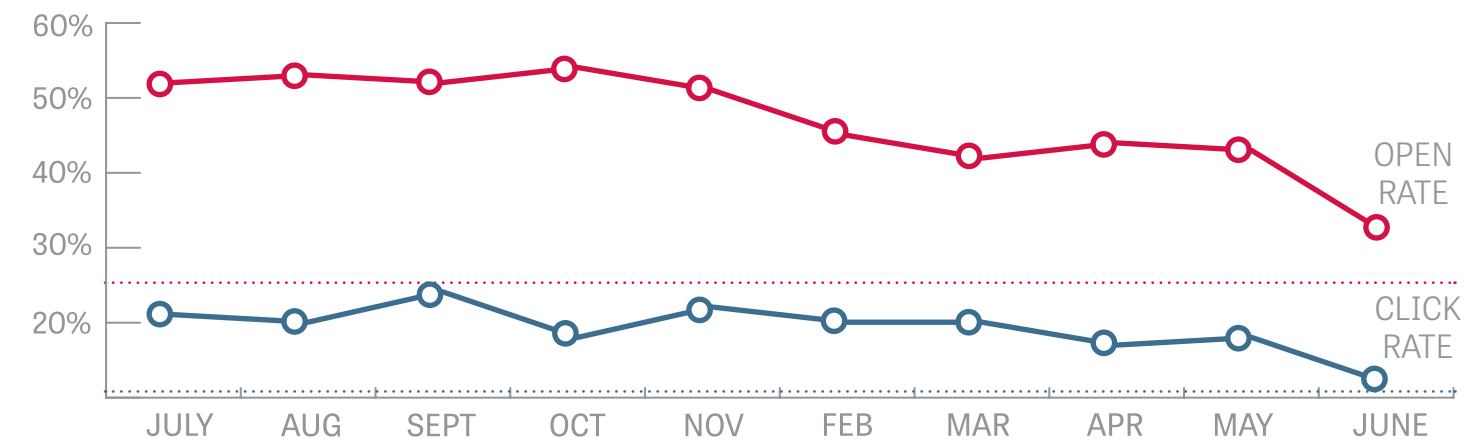

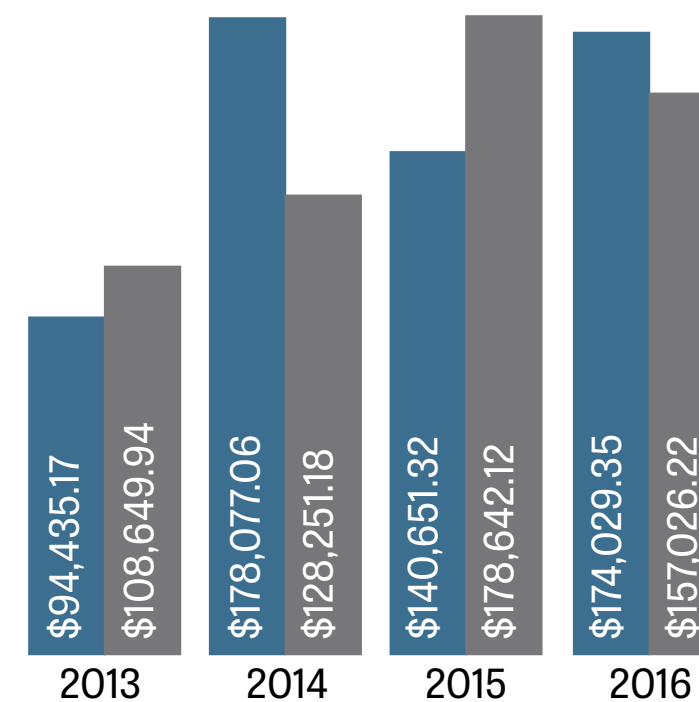

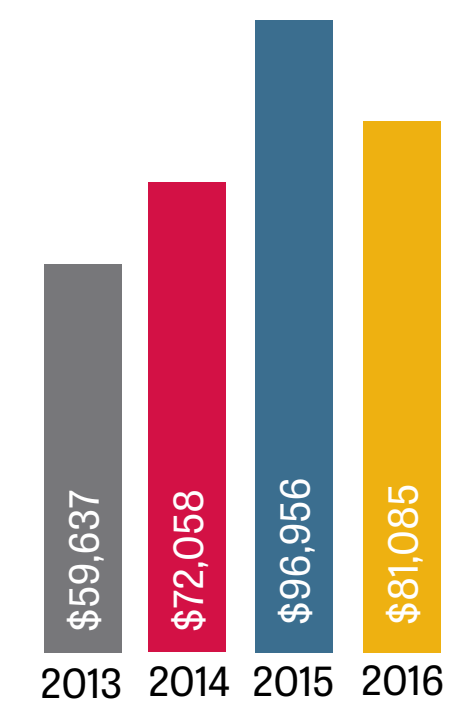
