For students enrolled in 4th year studio in the fall of 2017

### **CRITERIA**

**The AIA Las Vegas Scholarship Committee along with SH ARCHITECTURE will offer one (1) scholarship for use in the 2017 Fall Semester at UNLV School of Architecture. This scholarship is in the amount of \$2,000.**

**The SH ARCHITECTURE SCHOLARSHIP has been established to promote leadership in your Community and in the Profession through commitment and design.**

#### **Criteria for Selection:**

- Architecture students currently enrolled in 3rd year with full-time standing (12 credits) and entering 4th year for the 2017 Fall semester at UNLV School of Architecture.
- Good academic standing with a minimum B-Grade point average (3.0 or higher cumulative GPA is required for Design Studio Courses).
- Candidates will be judged on their leadership experience in community and professional leadership and involvement, but will not necessarily be eliminated due to lack of previous experience in this area.
- Candidates must provide a portfolio of projects evidencing design skills. The portfolio should provide examples of previous academic projects and/or personal work that can be architectural, graphic design, art, sculpture, etc.
- Portfolios must be submitted along with the completed application form in a PDF format. If the application is completed online, the PDF must be attached to the application form. If the application form is delivered to the AIA Office, the portfolio may be submitted on a CD or on a USB drive.
- AIA Las Vegas and SH Architecture reserves the right not to award this scholarship if it is determined by the committee that there are no qualified candidates.

#### **Process of the Award:**

- **All submissions must be received by 5:00PM on Monday, April 24, 2017** either by hand delivery, email or mail to Randy Lavigne, Hon. AIA, Executive Director of the AIA Las Vegas Chapter; Email:rlavigne@aianevada.org; Mailing/Physical Address: 401 S. Fourth Street, Suite 175, Las Vegas, NV 89101
- AIA Las Vegas Scholarship Committee and principals of SH ARCHITECTURE will evaluate the information provided on the scholarship application, and in the portfolio.
- Compliance with selection criteria will be verified. Members from the AIA Scholarship Committee will review the application materials.
- Principals of SH ARCHITECTURE will review each candidate application and portfolio and contact each applicant directly to arrange a personal interview, prior to making the final selection of the scholarship recipient.

The Award funds will be administered through the UNLV Student Financial Services Office allowing the student to use the money for tuition, books, housing and other costs related to their architectural studies.
